The Central Coast of California is home to some of the most unique and diverse soil types of any growing region in California



Aromas of black cherry, caramel sauce, dried herbs and crushed rocks lead into a palate shaped by strong yet relenting tannins. Flavors of oak and more dark cherry ride a silky mouthfeel.



- The diversity of soil types and microclimates in Paso Robles create near perfect growing conditions for Cabernet
- Growing season range from 93° F during the day, down to 54
 ° F at night.
- Vineyards in the Creston District develop thicker skins attributing structure and intensity
- Estrella District vineyards attribute bright, rich fruit characteristics
