

TREANA

2022 RED

Treana is the sum of elements that influence our wines; the land that our families farm, the warm California sun that nurtures, and the cooling ocean breeze that balances. These elements combine to create the perfect growing conditions for our grapes.

HARVEST NOTES

The 2022 growing season was slightly warmer than average throughout. While generally mild in spring with few frost events, the summer months were mild with unusually long heat events lasting five to seven days. Veraison was fairly mild, and berries quickly matured. Early September saw very warm temperatures for an extended period. This rapidly increased brix and grapes were harvested about a week earlier than normal.

We source Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah for Treana Red from 7 of Paso Robles' 11 districts, with most of the blend coming from three: Estrella, Geneseo, and Creston. The Estrella district, on the northeast side, has gravelly, well-drained soils from ancient riverbeds that produce fruit-forward wines. Geneseo, in the heart of the AVA, features rich alluvial soils that lend a velvety texture. Creston, southeast of Geneseo, sits on calcareous, gravelly plains that yield well-rounded, rich, and dark Cabernet Sauvignon.

WINEMAKING NOTES

After harvest, each vineyard lot was fermented separately in stainless steel tanks for 14 to 20 days. Carefully managed pump-overs and extended maceration enhanced color and tannin extraction. The varietals were then aged individually for 16 months in French Oak barrels, 25% of which were once or twice used. The initial blend was assembled in February 2023 and returned to 66% new French Oak for an additional 15 months of aging. The wine was racked only twice during its cellar life, with the final racking taking place just before bottling.

TASTING NOTES

This vintage Treana Red continues to showcase our legendary of Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah. The nose reveals aromas of dark fruit, cassis, and vanilla bean, while the palate displays vibrant notes of raspberry and fresh cherry. Layers of baking spice and subtle pepper add depth and complexity, leading to a long, balanced finish with well-integrated tannins. Full-bodied and expressive, this wine captures the bold character and elegance that define Treana Red.
