

# TREANA

## 2023 RED

*Treana is the sum of elements that influence our wines; the land that our families farm, the warm California sun that nurtures, and the cooling ocean breeze that balances. These elements combine to create the perfect growing conditions for our grapes.*

### HARVEST NOTES

The 2023 growing season was cooler and wetter than in recent years. Near-record rainfall filled soil profiles while a cooler spring and summer facilitated good vine growth but slowed berry and cluster development. The result was a later harvest. Fortunately, the autumn weather was warm and consistent which helped to fully mature berries. The result was a balanced crop with ripe fruit, high tannins and anthocyanins, all indicators of high quality.

We carefully source the grapes for this red blend from sub-districts in Paso Robles that consistently produce high quality: The Geneseo, Estrella, El Pomar and Creston Districts. We sourced Syrah from an El Pomar District vineyard with loamy soils and a temperate microclimate that helps produce richer color and balanced structure. The Cabernet Sauvignon was sourced from the other three districts, all with well-drained calcareous soils, and large, daily diurnal swings.

### WINEMAKING NOTES

After harvest, vineyard lots were fermented individually in stainless-steel tanks for 14 to 20 days. Carefully managed pump overs and extended macerations enhanced the extraction of color and tannin. The varietals were aged separately for 19 months in French Oak barrels, of which 25% were a mix of once and twice used. The initial blend was assembled in May of 2025 and barrel-aged an additional 3 months in 66% new French Oak. The wine was racked only twice during its cellar life, with the final racking occurring just prior to bottling.

### TASTING NOTES

This classic blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah opens with aromas of plum, black cherry, and fresh blackberries, accented by a touch of violet. The palate introduces notes of blueberry preserves and fig jam, supported by a hint of baking spices. Firm tannins and a rich, lush mouthfeel carry the wine to a long, satisfying finish.
