Story

A blending of Grenache and Syrah that is intentionally complex and uniquely delicious. Our estate Grenache is voluptuous, powerful with round tannins. Our estate Syrah is big and strong in its approach. Power and grace struggling to find symmetry. The fragile balance between the two is where harmony lives.

Palate

In the glass, the aromas of roasted coffee, tobacco, and hints of cocoa continue through to the palate where bright acidity is a surprising introduction before the full body evolves with flavors of fresh baked shortbread, strawberries and deep, dark chocolate. The wine lingers with soft, refined tannins.

Concept

The label is based on a Metatron's Cube, an ancient symbol of the flower of life. The cube consists of thirteen circles. The number thirteen is sacred, as it represents the thirteen divine laws of creation, the thirteen centers of energy in our human bodies, the thirteen energy centers of experience. It is said these thirteen circles hold the secrets to both evolution and divine spiritual enlightenment.

The symbol itself also represents the male and female aspects of existence; the left symbol is male and the right symbol is female. The straight lines represent male energy and the circles represent female energy. The words that are placed inside the circles are selected purposely. Each of them are properties of the male and female aspects of creation, which are the Latin names of four elements:
